After the death of a child, parents grieve in their own different ways, the siblings lose their sister or their brother and often, at least temporarily, their parents as stable caregivers.

How do parents experience this situation at work? How do siblings live with this situation at school?



How do doctors, psychologists, psychotherapists and grief counselors accompany family members who are often traumatized?

Just as each mourning for a child changes an individual, the funeral culture is also changing: in addition to TCF, new networks have been built--they learn from and with each other. Aspects of mourning have become subjects for research at many universities.
