What do your donations fund?

The Compassionate Friends receives no funding from national, regional or local government. We rely entirely on donations and fundraising activities. **Your donations helps us to cover:**

- £50 Enables 10 families to receive a bereavement support information pack.
- £100 Provide supportive leaflets to 6 local support groups in one region of the UK.
- £150 Funding for one bereaved parent volunteer to attend a training day for starting up and facilitating a support group for bereaved parents.
- £250 Provides a bursary for a bereaved parent or family member with financial limitations to attend a supportive weekend retreat.
- £300 Provides initial training and support for one bereaved parent volunteer to offer support to newly bereaved callers on our National Helpline.
